Online admission procedure to the B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. (Hons./Gen.) and BCA. (1st Semester) 1st Year Classes (2018-19) will be as per the following schedule:

- a) Date of issue of Online Form: **13.06.2018** onwards.
- b) Closing Date for Online Form Fill up: **26.06.2018 (midnight)**.
- c) Last date of submission of application Fee(s) through Bank Challan: **29.06.2018**.
- d) Publication of Merit List (Hons. and or Gen. Course): **02.07.2018**.
- e) Admission to the B.A./B.Sc./B.Com.(Honours) 1st Year Classes for the Session 2018-19 will be done as per merit list.

- **For Pass/General Course admission, separate application is to be submitted.**
- **Application for Honours Course shall not be treated as application for Pass/General Course.**

Detail Programme for admission to 1st Year classes will be notified later on.

1. The detail schedule of Online Registration for the Academic Session 2018 – 19 shall be intimated later on by the University authority.
2. Subject to the eligibility criteria, the merit lists for the General Courses will be prepared on the basis of Grand Total of best five subjects including English but excluding Environmental Studies.
3. Candidates qualifying in (10+2) Examination with English as a Subject of the West Bengal State Council for Vocational Education & Training shall have to comply with Sl. No. 4 and are eligible to get admission to B.A. and B. Com. General Course only.
4. Only the State Level and National Level Boards in regular mode will be allowed to take admission in Honours/General Courses.
5. The selection criteria and merit will be prepared as per the provisions of the University. The Merit Point Calculation will be done as follows:

- a) Subject to the eligibility criteria, the merit lists for the Honours will be prepared as:
Subject (opted for Honours) + Grand Total (as in clause 4 of this circular)

- b) In case any candidate opted for an Honours beyond his subject combination (Except linguistic subjects) at H.S. (10 + 2) Level, the merit lists for the Honours Courses will be prepared as:

0 (Zero) + Grand Total (as in clause 4 of this circular).
